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1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Document Provenance

This document is a formal deliverable of the *Mapping Business Processes for Washington State's Interagency Veteran Programs* project. It is one of nine total project deliverables:

1.2. Purpose

The purpose of this document is to elaborate the current state (as-is) of accessing and/using federal authoritative data at WDVA.

2. OVERVIEW OF FEDERAL DATA SOURCES

2.1. Introduction

WDVA uses numerous data resources at the federal level. The primary federal departments and administrations are:

- U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC)
- U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Veterans Benefits Administration (VBA)
- U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Veterans Health Administration (VHA)
- Social Security Administration (SSA)

While WDVA accesses data from both DMDC and VBA, we're not aware that the department accesses data from VHA or SSA. For the latter, client social security numbers are verified from SSA, but the request is issued from one of the VBA systems.

2.2. Applications and Systems as Data Sources

This section describes the applications and/or systems in use by federal agencies that source much of the data the WDVA references or uses. Most federal data is delivered through these applications, though not all. The PARIS quarterly match file is an example of authoritative federal data arriving via secure file transfer via DMDC and through DSHS's ACES platform. (This data exchange and delivery process is documented in Related Document 2 on page 7.)

2.2.1. eBenefits

eBenefits is a web-based portal that is the result of a collaboration between the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and the Department of Defense (DoD). The portal serves veterans, active duty service members, wounded warriors, their family members, and their authorized caregivers (users). eBenefits is a secure environment where users can safely access personal information and perform self-service tasks. User sign up for one of two accounts: a Basic account, which gives users limited access to various features; or a Premium account, which gives users unlimited access to features. Both require users to complete the DS Logon procedure¹.

Note: eBenefits is described here even though WDVA staff does not actively use it. Veterans Benefits Specialists (VBS), however, may work hand-in-hand with a client in using eBenefits.

eBenefits provides users with the following self-service capabilities:

- Submit a claim for disabilities.
- Apply for VA health care benefits.
- Apply for pension benefits.

- Apply for education benefits.
- Apply for burial benefits.
- Add or remove a child or spouse to a compensation award.
- Upload supporting documents for a submitted claim.
- Request a representative to handle a claim(s).
- File a consent to give non-VA medical providers permission to release medical records.
- Apply for financial assistance for specially adapted housing based on disabilities.
- Obtain eligibility for a VA-back home loan.
- Apply for vocational rehabilitation and employment benefits.
- Find and enroll in a TRICARE® health plan.

WDVA staff does not use eBenefits directly but they may help guide—especially at the Service Centers—clients who have an interest.

2.2.2. eGrants

eGrants is an online system supported by the federal Corporation for National and Community Service. It's designed to automate the entire grants and project management process from application to closeout, which includes:

- Submission and tracking grant applications and concept papers.
- Online grant application peer review.
- Negotiating and awarding grants and cooperative agreements,
- Managing grants and cooperative agreements including processing amendments, and continuations.
- Creating, submitting and editing your recruitment listings.
- Selecting applicants and searching for applicants.
- Financial Status and Progress Reporting.

2.2.3. MAP-D

Modern Award Processing Development (MAP-D) is an application in use at the VBA since 2003. MAP-D is designed to facilitate the development phase of claims processing, give federal veterans service representatives (VSRs) one tool to use to perform this work, and automate steps wherever possible. It can be considered the counterpart to SHARE. SHARE can't provide notations or documents; MAP-D can. It also allows for better visibility of a claims effective date and current status.

MAP-D shows a claim's status that is intended to indicate the approximate stage of processing. A claim's status can be used by VBA personnel to determine necessary actions and to provide more accurate customer service. Status indicators can also drive workload reports.

2.2.4. SHARE

Share is a Microsoft Windows®-based application which is utilized by the VBA's Regional Offices (RO) to access the Beneficiary Inquiry Records Locator System (BIRLS), Compensation and Pension (C&P) Master Records, Pending Issue File (PIF), Payment History File (PHF), Corporate database, Social Security Administration, and COVERS² records. Share provides a single computing system with data sources located on different databases in multiple locations.

Share allows employees at ROs to establish and manage PIF claim data. Share automatically creates claim data in the Benefit Delivery Network (BDN) and the Veteran Benefit Administration (VBA) Corporate database to support the case management of various types of C&P claims. The application replaces most of the current processes now performed in the BDN. Share does not have Claim Adjudication (CAUT) capabilities.

Share interfaces with other VBA systems and databases to retrieve veteran information. The VBA computer systems are as follows:

- BDN Pending Issue File
- C&P payment Master Records
- BIRLS records

VBA Corporate databases including RBA 2000, MAP-D case management and development, Loan Guaranty Services and Claims (LS&C), and Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment WINRS processing.

The corporate environment is defined as the "corporate" Sun Solaris and legacy systems accessible from the corporate applications. The records retrieved from Share processes are displayed in graphical windows. This application is the starting point for Modern Awards Processing (MAP).

The application users for Share are the employees of the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) who perform the functions of adding claims to the BIRLS system, BIRLS Folder Update, Change of Address, Change of Fiduciary, Change of Name, Diary Establishment, Claims Establishment, First Notice of Death, Pending Issue claim clear, cancel or change. The users are also given access to Master Record Inquiries, Payment History Inquiries, Pending Issue Inquiries, and BIRLS Record Inquiries. These functions are utilized by the Veteran Service Representative (VSR) position.

The level of authority for each user will vary according to the security access granted by the Security Officer (SO). This will limit the access to the functions on the Ready Screen.

Share allows a service officer to determine whether a veteran is in the VA system, and see their current representative. You can also view their corporate account and any information that may be needed (e.g. flash messages, claims status, diagnostic codes, awards, family info, etc.). Other features include a veteran's payment history (TINQ) and SHARE Cover Inquiry.

² COVERS is Control of Veterans Records System.

A Share COVERS Inquiry allows you to track a claim's history and see where it is currently located (e.g. Seattle, Houston, or Phoenix).

2.2.5. Stakeholder Enterprise Portal (SEP)

Stakeholder Enterprise Portal (SEP) provides a fully functional and secure entry point to web-based systems, information and services accessed on behalf of Veterans and the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) by external stakeholders, business partners and service providers (i.e. Veterans Service Organizations (VSOs)) SEP establishes a common enterprise identification and authentication service for VA internal and external stakeholders (herein "users") and provides a portal for the management of enterprise content for VA enterprise stakeholders.

SEP users can file a claim for compensation, file for dependency, and update a veteran's information. SEP also allows monitoring of the status of a veteran's claim. Because it is a web-based application, it can be used remotely.

From a system's perspective SEP can be considered a modern web-based front end for accessing the VONAPP³ Direct Connect environment (VDC). All requests and applications (i.e. transactions) originating from eBenefits or SEP are routed through VDC, which then commits the transactions into the VA Corporate Database, where it can then be accessed by other applications, such as Virtual VA or VBMS.

To use SEP, users are required to register using one of two methods:

- The Personal Identity Verification (PIV) card is issued by a Federal agency and is the standard identification card for all Federal employees and contractors. The PIV card is issued for secure access to Federal and other facilities and access to Federal computer networks and systems.
- The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) now offers Norton Symantec to access VA websites and applications. (A credit card is required to acquire a Norton Symantec account.)

2.2.6. Veterans Appeals Control and Locator System (VACOLS)

The Veterans Appeals Control and Locator System (VACOLS) allows on-line tracking of appeals. Effective tracking of appeals requires accurate updating of VACOLS each time action is taken on pending appeal cases. VACOLS is accessed through the Regional Office Access program which is found on VBA workstations. VSRs can track the issues a veteran is appealing, any notes or annotations from an adjudicator, and monitor a claim's current status.

2.2.7. Veterans Benefits Management System (VBMS)

VBMS is one of the new VBA tools in use at the Veterans Administration Regional Offices (VAROs) to help process veterans' claims faster and with less errors. It is a web-based, electronic claims processing portal created to give VA the ability to process claims paper-free. It is helping VBA move from a paper-based claims process to a digital one.

VBMS allows claims processors to do many things automatically that was once done manually, making the VBA workforce more efficient. Using VBMS, a veteran's claim-related evidence is digitized into an electronic file (or format) and sent from claims processors to medical examiners located offsite. VARO personnel spend less time searching for and transferring paper records and can spend more time processing claims. All the relevant information about a Veteran's claim is available instantly to all VA employees working on the claim.

VBMS allows those with access to view a veteran's personal information and service record, their claims information, current and historical documents received by the VA, rating issues, and updated notes from VARO personnel working on their file.

The system allows for real time management that helps a Service Officer monitor the status of a claim. When documents are sent to the VA they are tracked on this system. VBMS enables the VBA to implement a nationwide rating system (i.e. the ability to rate claims across the nation instead of regional areas).

2.2.8. Virtual VA (VVA)

Virtual VA Paperless Claims Processing is a web-based solution that provides electronic *eFolders* for claims processing through imaging, document management technologies, and integration with output capabilities of several other VA systems. VVA enables the Veterans Benefits Administration (VBA) to address timely processing of services to veterans, which has historically been hindered by the dependence on paper documents. VVA ensures security and privacy of veteran data by migrating from a vulnerable, paper claims folder to a secure, centralized, and electronic claims folder for compensation and pension processing. VVA also helps enable electronic document workflow processing, business process management, VA and DoD systems integration, national scanning of documents, and improved workflow management.

VVA provides users with the following capabilities:

- Electronic storage for applications and evidence coming into the Department of Veterans Affairs
- Electronic storage for all correspondence and ratings sent out from the Department of Veterans Affairs
- The ability for a user to categorize, search, and sort the contents of the eFolder to assist in evaluating the claim

VVA allows documents to be shared among the entire VA organization and even other government agencies such as Defense Finance and Accounting Services (DFAS) without the constraint of moving a physical folder. Other automated systems, such as VETSNET⁴, are able to use VVA as a storage repository for released correspondence and other documents.

VVA can accept claims from several sources: mail, fax, email, or via the VONAPP automated system which will provide submission of a claim application through the Internet. VVA stores the following types of documents:

- Most documents relating to a veteran's pension award (scanned in by Pension Management Centers)
- Documents generated by Debt Management Center
- Recent rating decisions and code sheets
- Recent decision notification letters
- BDN generated letters
- QTC examination results
- Notification Letters & Worksheets
- Comp COLA – End of Year Letters
- Write-outs
- Marine Corp Records (Korean/Vietnam Wartime)

3. AUTHORITATIVE FEDERAL DATA PASSED FROM FEDERAL TO STATE

WDVA programs and departments routinely utilize data from federal authoritative sources for a variety of means:

- To verify the identity of a client (SSN and veteran status are two common inquiries).
- To verify the authenticity of information either given informally by a client or submitted formally through an application.
- To validate eligibility of a client for one or more programs.
- To analyze a client's eligibility for financial benefits (or increases to existing financial benefits).
- To examine a client's claims status (and to advocate for that client as appropriate).

3.1. Certificate of Discharge (DD214) - Hardcopy

3.1.1. Summary

Veteran information being sent by WDVA to DSHS (see Related Document 2 on page 7) is derived solely from records stored in the *Certificate of Discharge* database⁵. The application that accesses the database is implemented in Access 2010 and is called *SQL2014CertificateOfDischarges*⁶. This database holds information received from veterans' Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty forms—known as *DD Form 214* (herewith *DD214*)—that WDVA receives from the Department of Defense's (DoD's) Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC). DMDC sends hardcopy DD214s to WDVA on a constant basis. Forms are mailed via US Postal Service when a sufficient number of forms are in the WDVA queue.

The hardcopy DD214 is actually eight pages: the original (copy 1), plus seven copies⁷. WDVA receives Copy 6, as do all other State Director of Veterans Affairs where veterans have indicated which, if any, State VA office they want Copy 6 delivered. Once hardcopies are logged into WDVA's Central Office, the Service Center's staff enters the information into *Certificate of Discharge* database.

3.2. Certificate of Discharge (DD214) – Electronic Copy

3.2.1. Summary

DMDC is currently in the process of rolling out a new web-based application, *Certificate of Release Discharge Information Reporting System (CRDIRS)*. CRDIRS will enable authorized users⁸ from State VA organizations to login and then download multiple electronic DD214s based on a given date range. At a point of time following the date range query, the user will receive a notification email that the DD214 records specified for the date range and for the State DVA are available for download. The user will then be able to download the file under secure FTP. The file format will be Comma-Separated Value (CSV). See Related Document 9 on page **Error! Bookmark not defined.** for a representative sample electronic DD214 file.

The State of Washington DVA is poised to begin participating as one of seven pilot State VA organizations pending contract completion. This initiative represents a huge leap forward for WDVA with the following immediate benefits:

- Reduction or elimination of data quality errors due to typographical errors.
- Increase in speed of availability of data for institutional use.

Of course, work will have to be planned and performed to read (i.e. parse) the DD214 CSV file so it can be uploaded into the *Certificate of Discharge* database. Additional work to avoid duplication of records should also be undertaken.

Once this is implemented, WDVA along with DSHS Client Registry, has at its discretion to share additional DD214 information that is both of high data quality and predictable in format.

Another opportunity exists to retroactively request DD214 records of veterans who already exist in the current *Certificate of Discharge* database. Though there will be some investment in work as noted above, this could represent a significant positive impact on the data quality of existing records.

In Related Document 2 on page 7, we made specific recommendations how DMDC can already improve upon the structure of this file.

3.4. PARIS Match Data

3.4.1. Summary

Once per quarter, DSHS’s ACES production team sends a file called the *State of Washington VA Match File* to DMDC. DMDC then appends successfully matched records with PARIS⁹ data from the following sources: The Veterans Administration Match; Department of Defense/Office of Personnel Management Match (regarding active or retired military and Federal employees); and the Interstate Match (duplicate payments made to the same client in more than one State). The ACES production team then posts an Excel file to the HCA Veterans Benefit Program Manager, who accesses it via SFTP. Information from this file is then combined into the updated *LTC Applicant Regional Referrals File*, now called the *Enhanced LTC Applicant Regional Referrals File*. Note: only a small percentage of LTC recipient records return a PARIS Match “hit”.

⁹ The Public Assistance Reporting Information System (PARIS) is a federal-state partnership that insures the integrity of public assistance programs through detecting and deterring improper payments. PARIS works with all 50 states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico to assist them in maintaining the honorable intentions of public programs.
